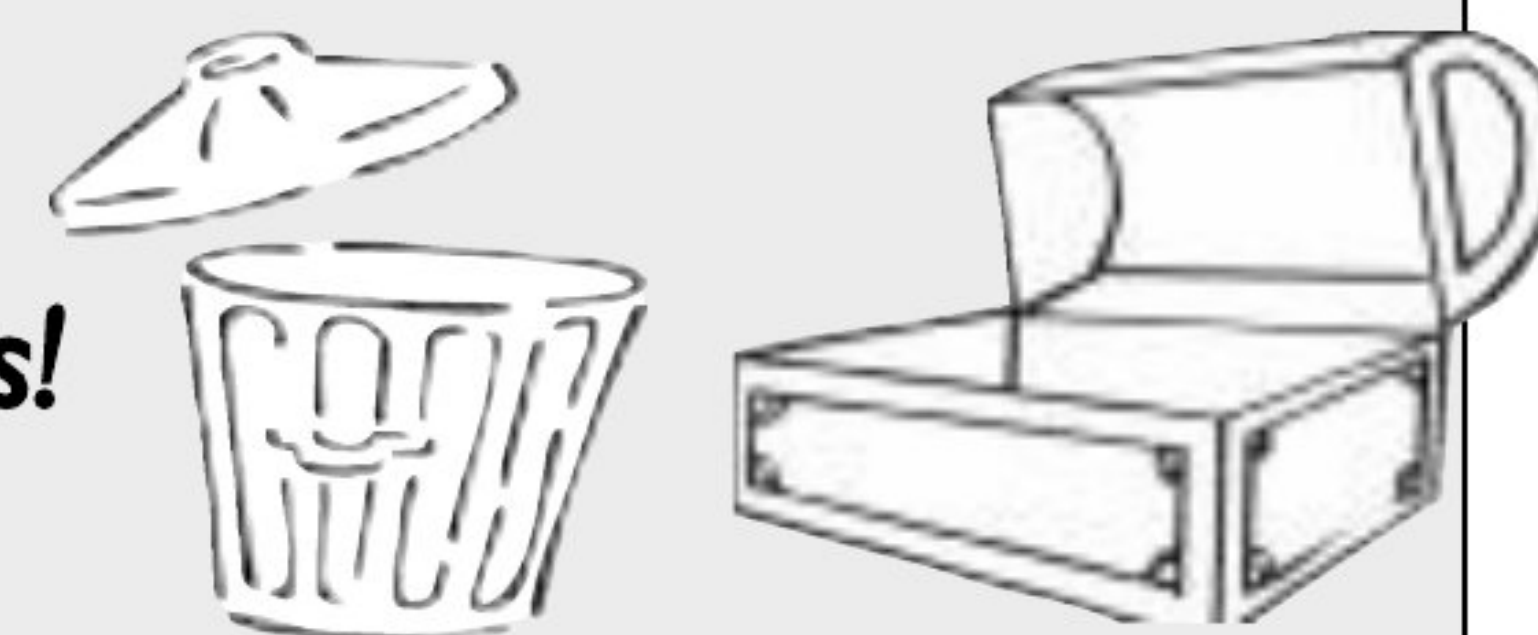

HOW TO GET TO ATLANTIC CITY

BY LAND: From the north, major interstate highways connect with the Garden State Parkway south. Take exit 38A to the Atlantic City Expressway. From the south, I-95 to Delaware Memorial Bridge to Route 40 to Route 322, or via Lewes Delaware, take the Cape May—Lewes Ferry to Garden State Parkway north, to Atlantic City Expressway. From the west via Philadelphia, Walt Whitman Bridge to North-South Freeway to Atlantic City Expressway. The convention center is prominently positioned at the base of the Atlantic City Expressway. Estimated drive times: Philadelphia 60 minutes, New York City 2-1/2 hours, Washington D.C. 3-1/2 hours.

BY RAIL: The NJ Transit Rail Terminal is directly adjacent to the convention center and connects "America's Favorite Playground" to Philadelphia at 30th Street Station and Amtrak's Northeast corridor lines. For more information, call (800) ACTRAIN, or visit their web site at www.njtransit.com.

BY AIR: Atlantic City International Airport is a convenient 20 minute ride from Atlantic City. Scheduled carriers servicing ACIA include U.S. Airways Express (800) 428-4322. Spirit Airlines (800) 772-7117, and Continental Airlines Express (800) 523-3273. Philadelphia International Airport is about 60 minutes away.

PHILADELPHIA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

RAPID ROVER: Service is based on demand and is picked up in the PIA baggage claim area (ground transportation desk), dial 21 on the phone. Call (856) 428-1500 or (800) 322-8062.
