

ERA News Last Chance for Current Version Joe Davis Seminar

Sponsored by Electrical Rebuilder's Association (ERA), the Technical Education Series featuring Joe Davis will undergo some changes for 2007. The class that Davis has been teaching on Friday evenings for the last two years, "How Starters, Generators and Alternators Really Work," will come to an end at the Ft. Lauderdale, Fla. event December 8 and 9. A new class will take its place beginning in January.

"Ninety-eight percent of the attendees at the Friday night seminar stated on the evaluation form that they would

"The next seminar will start with component test and problem solving—a step-by-step procedure to follow when the alternator or starter does not operate properly.
